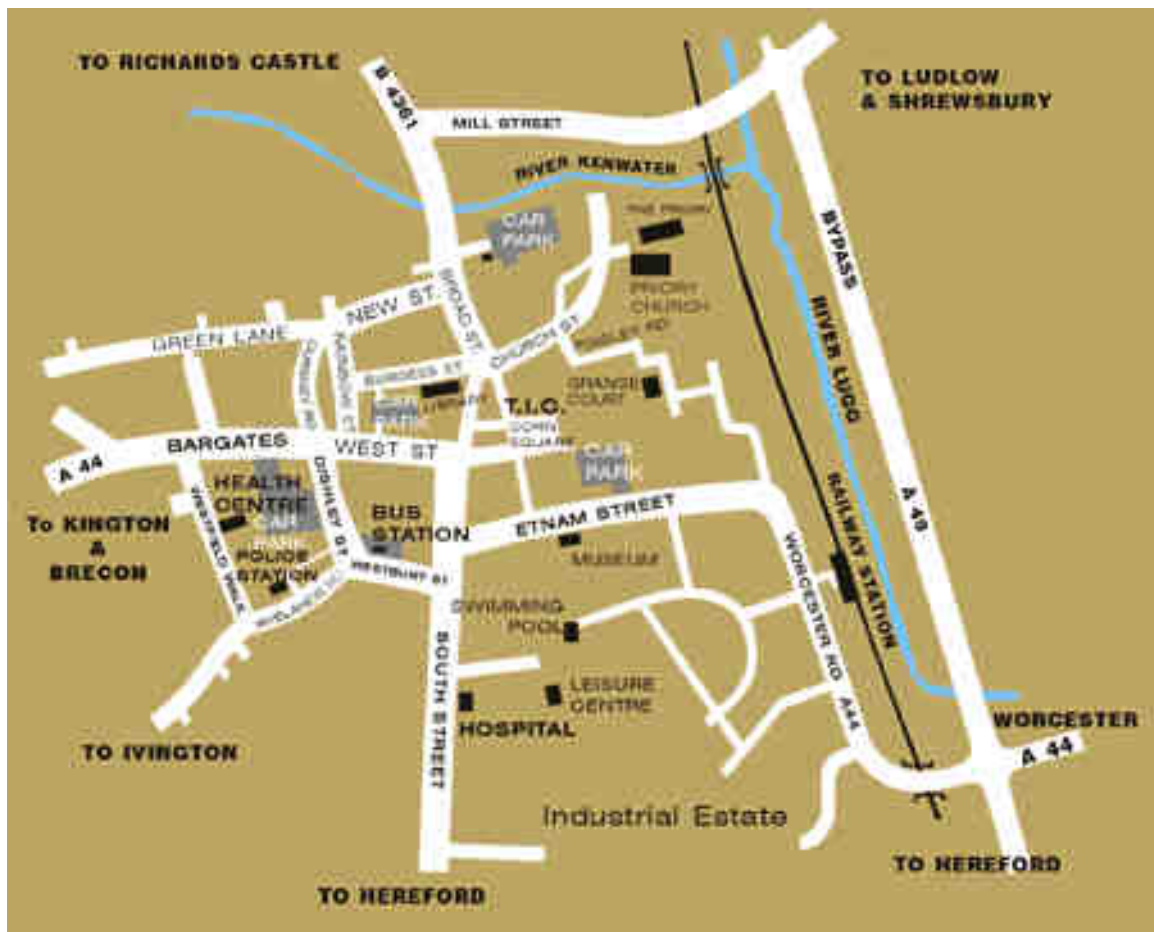


Directions to Priory Church, Leominster



Leominster can be reached by road or train (and probably by bus as well, but this is Sunday in rural Britain, so don't bank on it). Trains run from Shrewsbury, so take a train there from Birmingham, Wolverhampton or wherever and change. I'd suggest looking at www.thetrainline.com for times.

By road, approach using the A456 from Birmingham via Kidderminster and Tenbury Wells, then turn left onto the A49 when you reach that at Woofferton. At a roundabout with the A44, take that road into the town centre. There is a one-way system in operation, and you can't get into Broad St from the A44, but have to swing round into New St and take the next left (Rainbow St) instead, then left again straight away into Burgess St. You emerge from Burgess St into Broad St opposite the Grape Vaults, here turn right then immediately left into Church St. The Priory Church is straight ahead at the end of this street. Parking is available in a small car park reached by following the road as it turns left at the church, or on some of the streets around the church. Owners of larger instruments may park within the church grounds. Please do your best not to inconvenience others by inconsiderate parking.

If all else fails, Leominster is not very big, and a local person will no doubt help you if you look lost. Or you can ask a policeman.
